Brief Description of Initiative	<p>Trowbridge Town Council currently provides the second largest CCTV scheme in the county, in partnership with Wiltshire Police, local businesses and the Shires Shopping Centre monitoring suite.</p> <p>We have invested this year to bring the system up to national standards for recording and in partnership with Tesco and TCAF Community Safety have added an additional camera.</p> <p>The Police and the Town Council would like to link the system into Trowbridge Police Station via a wireless link to give police officers direct access to images to increase detection and reduce anti-social behaviour.</p>

This makes Trowbridge a safer place and makes the community more satisfied with the community safety services provided by the Police and local Councils. Further improvements will improve the situation by providing a direct link to the police station, reducing the amount of time spent by officers and PCSOs travelling to the control room.
