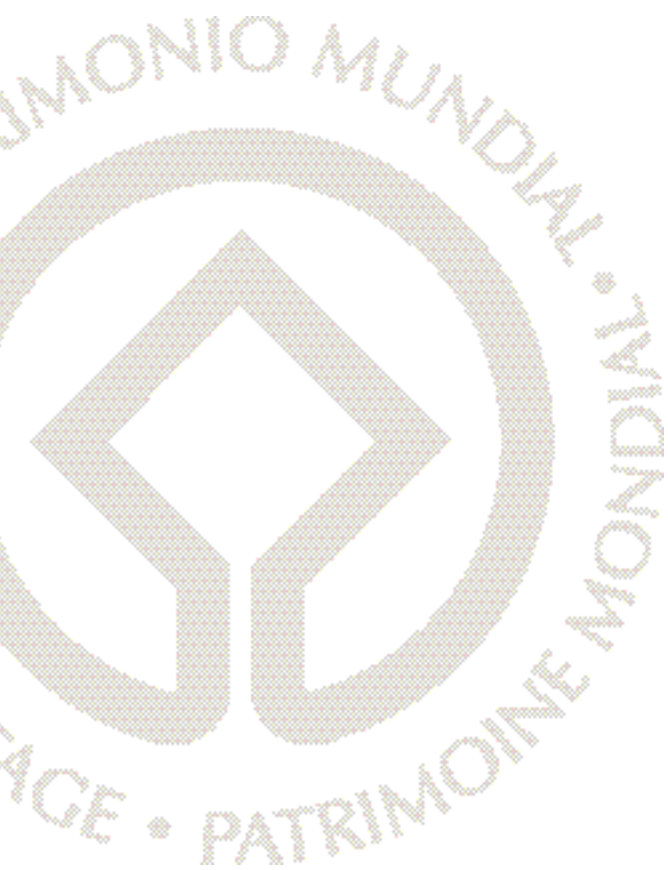




The facade of West Kennet Long Barrow
