Wiltshire Day Rover tickets allow you unlimited travel on the buses of the participating companies as listed. The system is simple. You board your first bus and pay the driver, who will give you a Wiltshire Day Rover ticket.

When you receive your Day Rover ticket, please check that the date and price are correct.

Remember the Wiltshire Day Rover ticket is *only* valid on the services of the bus companies listed overleaf.

Please note that if you possess an English National Bus Pass, you can travel on these buses free of charge after 9.30am on weekdays or at any time at weekends without the need to purchase a Day Rover ticket. In addition pass-holders who live in Wiltshire can also use their bus passes before 9.30am on most services – please enquire for details.

Avebury Stone Circle, West Kennet Long Barrow, Alexander Keiller Museum, the Great Barn and other sites. Served by service 49 from Devizes, Trowbridge and Swindon; and 'Connect2 Wiltshire' from Marlborough and Calne.

Bath Roman Baths, Pump Room, Abbey, Holburne Museum, Royal Crescent, the Circus, shops, theatres, cinemas, postal and costume museums, and the American Museum. Served by service 265 from Salisbury, Warminster, Westbury, Trowbridge and Bradford-on-Avon; service 228 from Colerne; services 231, X31 from Chippenham and Corsham; 271, 272 and X72 from Devizes and Melksham.

Bradford on Avon Saxon Church 14th C. bridge, Tythe Barn, Kennet and Avon Canal, delightful walks in historic Town and by River Avon. Served by 265 from Bath, Trowbridge, Westbury, Warminster and bus 69 from Melksham and Corsham.

Castle Combe Picturesque Cotswold village with museum. Served by service 35 from Chippenham.

Cirencester Historic Cotswold town, Corinium Museum, Roman remains. Served by service 51 from Swindon; 93 from Malmesbury.

Corsham Corsham Court and the underground quarry centre. Served by services 231 and X31 from Bath and Chippenham; 68/69 bus from Melksham and Trowbridge.

Devizes Devizes is the centre of the Wiltshire bus network. It is a pleasant market town with access to the Kennet and Avon Canal and its famous Caen Hill Locks. Regular services link the town to Salisbury – service 2; Swindon, Avebury and Trowbridge – service 49; Melksham and Bath – services X72 and 271; Calne and Chippenham – service 33/X33; Westbury – service 87.

Kennet and Avon Canal runs from Reading to Bristol attracting thousands of visitors a year. Service 265 Warminster to Bath route, stops at Bradford on Avon. Service 271 and X72 Bath and Melksham to Devizes. Service 49 Trowbridge to Devizes, also Avebury and Swindon. The 'Connect2 Wiltshire' also serves some points.

Lacock Rustic photogenic village with Abbey and the Fox Talbot Museum. Much used as a film location. Served by services 234, X34 from Chippenham, Trowbridge and Melksham.

Malmesbury Oldest borough in England, market town, Abbey. Served by services 41 from Yate; 31 from Swindon; 93 from Cirencester; 92 from Chippenham.

Marlborough Fine Georgian market town, Merchant's House Museum, old coaching inns and tea rooms. Served by services 48,70,X5 from Swindon; 20/22 from Hungerford; X5 from Salisbury; 80 from Ludgershall and Tidworth; 'Connect2 Wiltshire' from Calne and Avebury.

Salisbury Cathedral, Mompesson House, local museums, Wilton House, Old Sarum. Served by services 2 from Devizes; 8 from Ludgershall and Tidworth; 27 and 29 from Shaftesbury; 34 from Romsey; X5 from Marlborough and Swindon; X7 from Southampton; 265 from Bath.

Swindon Town centre shops, outlet village, theatres and cinemas. Served by services 31 from Malmesbury; 46 and 90 from Hungerford; 48,70,X5 from Marlborough; 49 from Devizes and Trowbridge; 51 from Cirencester; 55 from Chippenham and Calne; 66 from Oxford; and local services within Swindon Borough.

Trowbridge County town with museum and thriving shopping centre. Served by services 49 from Swindon and Devizes; 234, X34 from Frome, Chippenham and Melksham; 265 from Bath, Bradford, Westbury Warminster and Salisbury. 68 or 69 from Corsham.
