**NOTICE OF ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC
PLACES ORDER (NO. 1) 2004**

Notice is hereby given that on 21 January 2004, Kennet District Council made an Order under Section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001, designating the Public Places within Devizes and surrounding parishes set out in the Schedule as places where the Police may require persons not to consume intoxicating liquor and to surrender any open containers of intoxicating liquor which the Police may dispose of.

Failure to comply with the requirements of the Police is an arrestable offence, and on summary conviction, the person responsible will be liable to a fine not exceeding Standard Scale level 2 (currently £500).

The Order will take effect on 6 February 2004.
