ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES

(WARMINSTER ORDER No 1)

The Wiltshire Council (in this Order called "the Council") at a meeting of the full Council on 13 July 2010 by resolution made the following Order under s13(2) of the above Act;


1. The land described in the Schedule below and shown on the map attached to this Order, being public places in the area of the Council which are public spaces in which the consumption of alcohol has been associated with disorder, nuisance to members of the public or a section of the public, is hereby designated for the purposes of s13(2) of the above Act.

In accordance with paragraph 4 of part 3B of the Wiltshire Council Constitution (Council's Scheme of Delegation to Officers) and in exercise of the powers delegated to me thereby, I hereby order that the above Order of the full Council may be cited as the Alcohol Consumption in Designated public Places for Warminster Order (No1) 2010 and shall come into force on 11th December 2010.

SCHEDULE

All public places within the area identified on the map attached to this Order and bounded by the red line; being land within the town of Warminster and to include all streets and public open spaces.
