Member of the Welsh Senior Women's Hockey team. She was part of their 2018 Commonwealth Games team. Emily is aiming to be part of the squad that competes at the Euro Championships later this year.



Jack Alexander – Fullbore target shooting

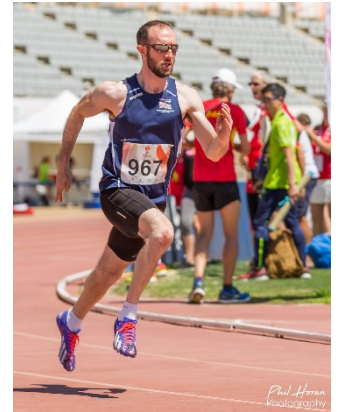

At 2018 European Transplant Championships as well as being chosen as Team Captain, he won five gold medals – in the 100 metres, 200 metres, 400 metres, javelin, and the 4x100m relay. 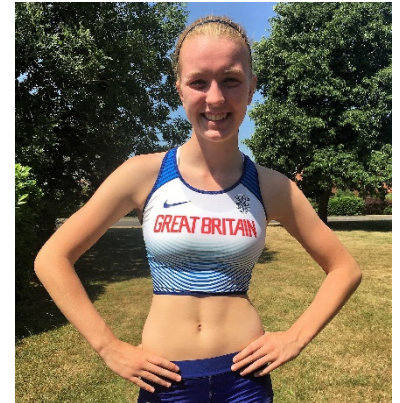
Jessica Daykin – Gymnastics
