Sign up for our Early Support Roadshows

As part of the Families and Children's Transformation (FACT) programme we are hosting some roadshows to update professionals on what changes have already been agreed to Early Support and consult on future changes too. They include:

- Roll out of new Safeguarding Threshold Guidance (includes a new Matrix tool replacing the 'Windscreen')
- Roll out of new Early Support Assessment (to replace CAF)
- Future DART development
- Roll out of IT-enabled joint working (making it easier to provide early support together)
- Relaunch of MAF's – best practice, policy and protocols

These sessions are for professionals with a designated safeguarding responsibility within their setting or organisation, as well as any practitioner who might be a CAF completer, lead professional or attend a MAF.

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Whole Life Pathway



Two workshops were held in April and May looking at developing a programme of work to improve outcomes for people with special educational needs and/or disabilities and care leavers.

The focus was on developing clear life pathways that enable people to be as independent and adventurous as possible in their own communities.

The workshops were hosted by Lucy Townsend, Director for Families and Children's Services and Claire Edgar, Director for Learning Disabilities and Mental Health. They were well attended by colleagues from health, social care, Wiltshire Parent Carer Council and Wiltshire Centre for Independent Living. The learning from work already undertaken within and outside of the FACT Programme was shared and groups looked at which people might be included in the initial phase of the programme, what the vision and objectives for the work

might be, what's currently working well and what could be improved.

Co-production is a key priority so watch this space for more information!

CMS latest news- Phase 2 update

The CMS programme team is progressing with development work on the new Liquidlogic solution to roll out additional functionality for Families and Children's Services.

Teams from the Early Years and Education System have been testing out the new systems.

We are also progressing our work with external partners to test a portal where they can add information.

With the pilot for this scheme staff within social care/early help will be able to send out parts of a form for external professionals to complete electronically and return via the portal. Exciting times and we will keep you updated on progress!
