Examples of Bids already received!

- A bid from a Residents Association in Salisbury for fresh white line painting in the communal carpark and a shed and tools for the communal gardening club
 - A bid from residents of Harnham for new play equipment and resurfaced play areas next to the local playpark and to create outdoor decking and seating areas for residents of flats without gardens to enjoy.
- A bid from residents of Downton for fresh white line painting in the communal carpark.

The application process is simple

1. Residents come together and decide what they would like to be done as a community.
2. A list of names and signatures from tenants agreeing and supporting what work they would like done.
