

EXHIBITIONS POLICY FOR LIBRARIES

Policy statement

1. Procedures for booking exhibition spaces or galleries in libraries are to follow standard booking procedures and terms and conditions.
2. Prior to the confirmation of a booking, a representative selection of the works or materials to be exhibited is to be shown to the Art Curator (Salisbury) or to the Librarian responsible for the space concerned.

Content

3. The content of all creative works must be of an acceptable artistic quality.
4. Bookings will not be accepted for exhibitions or displays that include racist, sexist or discriminatory content, or are unsuitable for viewing by children or otherwise deemed to be offensive. The acceptance of exhibition and display bookings will conform to current Wiltshire Council policies.

Health and safety and security

5. All artworks should be securely mounted so as to form no risk or endanger the public. Advice on security should be sought from the designated library contact.
6. All security regarding artworks is the exhibitor's responsibility.

Final decision

7. The final decision on acceptance of exhibits or displays rests with the Assistant Director, Libraries, Heritage and Arts on the advice and recommendations of the Art Curator (Salisbury) or local Librarian.
