Purpose of the forums

1. Provide mutual support for staff.
2. Help inform all staff about equality and diversity issues and raise awareness.
3. Advise management on how to improve the quality of working life for staff from minority groups.
4. Contribute a powerful voice for all.

The forums

- We currently have two staff forums. Could you be part of one of these groups, or do you know someone who would benefit? Do you have any ideas for other staff groups which support diversity?
- The forums have the full support of the chief executive and the leader of the council.
- You would be able to attend meetings which are held bi-monthly.
- Staff can network and support each other by email, telephone and face-to-face.
- Meetings across the county and at different times.

Staff disability forum

- If you have a disability or hidden impairment, your experiences will be valued in the forum.
- Members are provided with a supportive space to share information and resolve practical issues related to disability.

Black and minority ethnic forum

- The forum is open to all employees across the council who consider themselves to be BME as well as other individuals who may be subject to discrimination and harassment on the basis of their own ethnicity, nationality or faith, or of those with whom they are associated.

Activities have included

- Promoting partnership events like 'No Barriers' (Dec) and Black History Month (Oct).
- Initiating equality network lunches.
- Promoting multi-faith and non faith awareness.
