

# Call for sites

## Why a call for sites?

At the end of the process, land will be identified for new Gypsy, Traveller and Travelling Showpeople sites. It is important we establish where there are existing aspirations for such uses as soon as possible in the process so they can be assessed thoroughly.

To begin to identify where sites may be available, landowners, agents or any other interested parties are being invited to submit land for consideration - a 'Call for Sites'.

Preferably sites should be in or near to existing settlements with access to local services. This does not mean that sites in more remote and rural locations will not be considered.

**If you are aware of any land suitable for Gypsies and Travellers or Travelling Showpeople please contact Wiltshire Council.**

## What information is needed about the site?

- Land ownership (if known)
- Existing use
- Potential future use, for example permanent or transit, plots for Travelling Showpeople
- Plans or photographs
- An indication of the number of pitches the site could provide.

Please note that by giving this information you are accepting that the information can be available to view by any other person under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

## How will the sites be assessed?

The sites will be assessed only after the close of this consultation and when agreement has been reached on the details of the proposed site selection methodology.

The information provided by the assessment will inform which sites are then taken forward for inclusion in the Gypsy and Traveller Site Allocations DPD.
