Core Strategy: Issues Raising Consultation

Kennet : Making Places for the Future

Carolyn Gibson, Principal Planning Officer, drew Members' attention to a set of papers that had been distributed with the Agenda, explaining various aspects of the consultation on the future development of the local planning framework. Members were encouraged to complete the questionnaire contained in the pack online through the Council's website. Members were informed of four further meetings planned to discuss the issues raised in the consultation papers in more detail taking place on: 26 March 2007 in Devizes; 13 March 2007 in Marlborough; 19 March 2007 in Pewsey and 2 April 2007 in Tidworth. The meetings were open to parishes and other interested organisations.

The Principal Planning Officer informed the Forum that a design code for Devizes which had been developed as a result of the Gillespies Land Use Study during 2005 would be sent out to parishes the following week.

The Area Administrator, in response to a question from a Parish Councillor, agreed that all parish clerks in Kennet would be sent a set of the Core Strategy papers in addition to those packs already provided to the nominated Forum representatives.

11. LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK

Papers were circulated prior to the meeting and Ed White informed the group that a consultation event was being planned for 13th March at Marlborough Town Hall. He urged everyone to get involved and stressed the importance. There was some concern that with elections in May and the short notice for consultation that some Parish Councils would not be having a meeting during the consultation period. Ed was asked if the power lines were being installed underground at the Salisbury Road Business Park. This was confirmed. He was then asked if young people could get involved in this consultation. Ed White confirmed that a response would be welcomed and that if necessary someone from KDC could come along to explain the process.

6. KENNET: MAKING PLACES FOR THE FUTURE

Ed White, Team Leader, Forward Planning & Transportation, Kennet District Council introduced the Core Development Strategy and explained that it would replace the adopted Kennet Local Plan.

The process had been divided up into three stages:

Issue-raising
Options
Preferred option

The findings would then be presented to the planning inspector for consideration. Mr White requested that after consulting their respective authorities, those present replied using their consultation packs, which they were encouraged to reply to from the Kennet District Council web site.

Four stakeholder meetings would follow the return of consultation packs, with the Tidworth Community Area one taking place on the 2nd of April.

9. KENNET: MAKING PLACES FOR THE FUTURE

A brief introduction to the "Making Places for the Future" consultation was given to emphasise this was the first of three phases of consultation leading to the preparation of planning policies to replace the current Kennet Local Plan. The four issues papers that had been prepared had been drawn from evidence gathered by Kennet and the existing community strategies. The purpose of this first phase of consultation was to make sure all issues relevant to the district in general and the Pewsey Community Area in particular were raised early in the process.

The planning partnership gave consideration to a pack covering planning issues that Kennet District Council believed were important in Kennet. The district council was seeking views on how future planning policy should now be developed.

The chairman indicated that although parish councils and individual councillors could and should also respond to the documentation he intended to go through the questionnaire paragraph by paragraph in order to try and formulate some answers on behalf of the Partnership. It would not however be possible to give answers to all of the questions as these were somewhat subjective for the community planning partnership to discuss.

This generated a considerable amount of interesting discussion which, although not always unanimous, produced a majority partnership opinion in the end.

Carolyn Gibson, Principal Planning Officer for Kennet District Council, drew Members attention to a set of consultation papers that had been circulated with the agenda. The meetings were open to Parishes and other interested organisations.

The Partnership was also advised that the Devizes Design Code, a paper generated as a result of the Gillespies Consultation on land use, had been published, and that comments were sought by the 16th April, 2007.

It was agreed that the Council's Forward Planning Department would arrange an additional meeting for Members of the Partnership to discuss the issues raising consultation as the Devizes meeting clashed with a meeting of Devizes Development Partnership.
