How should Kennet develop over the next twenty years? During March and April Kennet's residents will have the opportunity to voice their views and influence the nature of changes and improvements in the district over the period to 2026.

The blueprint for Kennet's future will be set out in a new planning document called the CORE STRATEGY. To begin to consider what the CORE STRATEGY should contain the Council has prepared ISSUES PAPERS for discussion on housing, environment, economy and community. Each paper raises questions for debate.

It is important that the right issues are covered now to ensure that the future development of the district reflects the main aspirations and concerns of all the Kennet communities
