#### **STERT – Prohibited Streets**

- Stert Lane from its junction with the A342 to its end at a bridleway, including the spur to the Manor Farm entrance.
- Fullway Lane from its junction with Stert Lane at Fullway Cottage to the cattle grid beyond Fullway Farm.
- The Etchilhampton Road from its junction with the A342 to the Etchilhampton/Stert Parish Boundary

#### **WOODBOROUGH – Prohibited Streets**

- The C261 for its length from the village sign at the Eastern side of Woodborough, through Free Trade and the centre of the village to the Western end, terminating at the Broad Street/Smithy Lane crossroads on the C38 to include Church Road and Church Farm Lane.
- The C38 from the village sign at the Northern end of the village (known as The Sands) through the Broad Street/Smithy Lane crossroads and to the village sign at the Southern end, just before the C38 bridge across the main railway line to include Smithy Lane and Hurst Lane for the whole of their lengths.
