## **GUIDANCE NOTES**

### **STREET TRADING**

In certain areas of Wiltshire it is illegal to trade from a stall in the street or on any land to which the public has access, including car parks, forecourts and similar areas, without first obtaining a Street Trading consent from Wiltshire Council.

You do not need a Street Trading Consent if you are operating as part of a market or if you are selling outside of your own shop, cafe or public house.

Hawkers, people who move about whilst selling rather than operating from a fixed stall, do not need Street Trading Consents, but must be registered with the Police.

A Street Trading Consent is not required in areas which are not covered by Consent Street Orders, but wherever you trade you will need the consent of the landowner and possibly Planning consent.
