1	Secondary gritting route	<p>Parishes covering Sherston, Luckington & Alderton, Norton & Foxley, Easton Grey and St Paul Malmesbury Without had been invited to reach a consensus about a proposed change to the secondary gritting rout suggested by Norton & Foxley parish council earlier in the year. The 3 constraints were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the ability of the vehicle to gain access • capacity of the vehicle • time available <p>A range of variations were considered using maps and the expertise of the officers involved in delivery the service. The aim was not to isolate any community and to encourage local people to access the main roads (primary gritted routes) rather than relying on back roads.</p> <p>Tertiary gritting was also discussed – this was provided in very poor weather via Land rover – a map of tertiary routes was requested.</p>	Attached to these minutes is the agreed provisional secondary gritting route to be adopted this winter, assuming it can be completed in the time allocated, plus the a copy of the tertiary route which had not been changed.
