**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (A350, FURZE HEDGE, CHICKLADE AND EAST KNOYLE) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURN) ORDER 2009**

The Council of the County of Wiltshire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any heavy commercial goods vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight to proceed along the length of road specified in Column A of the Schedule to this Order, to make a right hand turn into the length of road specified in Column B of the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into operation on xxxxxxxx 2009 and may be cited as The County of Wiltshire (A350, Furze Hedge, Chicklade and East Knoyle) (Prohibition of Right Hand Turn) Order 2009.
