1. The Wiltshire and Swindon Minerals Development Control Policies: Revised Preferred Options Report	This document sets out the Mineral Planning Authorities policy direction in terms of managing the land use aspects of minerals developments over the period from 2006 to 2026.
2. The Wiltshire and Swindon Waste Development Control Policies: Revised Preferred Options Report	This document sets out the Waste Planning Authorities policy direction in terms of managing the land use aspects of waste developments over the period from 2006 to 2026.
