### Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 The Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004

In accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 notice is given that Salisbury District Council formally adopted its Statement of Community Involvement on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2006.

The Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) sets out how the community will be involved in the preparation of local development documents, which will form Salisbury District's Local Development Framework (LDF), and consultation on planning applications. The LDF will be the statutory development plan and will form the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting the district.

An independent Inspector was appointed by the Government to examine the 'soundness' of the submitted SCI. The Inspector reported back to the district council on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2006 setting out the binding changes to be made to the submitted SCI.
