

## **Wiltshire Council - Notice of Proposal to Make a Prescribed Alteration to Larkrise Community Special School to Change the Nature of Special Educational Needs Provision and the Age Range**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Wiltshire Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Larkrise Community Special School, Ashton Street, Trowbridge, BA14 7EB from 01 September 2011.

Wiltshire Council proposes to change the school's designation from Moderate Learning Difficulties (MLD) and Severe Learning Difficulties (SLD) for pupils aged 4 to 19 years to Severe Learning Difficulties (SLD)/Autistic Spectrum Disorders (ASD) for pupils aged 3 to 19 years. There will be no change to the school's existing capacity of 78 pupil places.

The school is currently making provision for the following special educational needs: Severe Learning Difficulties (SLD)/Autistic Spectrum Disorders (ASD), for pupils aged 3 to 19 years. Historically, it has been inappropriately designated as providing for pupils aged 4 to 19 years with Moderate Learning Difficulties (MLD) and Severe Learning Difficulties (SLD). No existing pupils therefore require alternative provision as a result of the proposed designation change.
