#### **Proposed title of the Development Plan Document:**

Salisbury district Local Development Framework Core Strategy Development Plan Document (Preferred Options).

#### **Proposed subject matter and area of the Development Plan Document:**

The Core Strategy Development Plan Document provides an over-arching framework for the Salisbury district Local Development Framework up to the year 2026. It is based upon Regional Planning Guidance 10, Wiltshire and Swindon Structure Plan 2016 and the draft South West Regional Spatial Strategy 2006-2026. All other Development Plan Documents which the council will produce will be in conformity with the Core Strategy.

The Core Strategy identifies the key issues facing Salisbury district and translates these into a spatial vision, strategic aims and objectives, a spatial strategy, core policies and a monitoring and implementation framework. The Core Strategy will make strategic site specific allocations.

The Core Strategy covers the whole administrative area of Salisbury district except for that area where the New Forest National Park is the local planning authority.
