1. The Wiltshire and Swindon Minerals Core Strategy - Submission Draft Document	This document sets out the County and Borough Councils vision, objectives and strategic spatial approach to meeting the need for minerals over the period 2006 - 2026.
2. The Wiltshire and Swindon Waste Core Strategy - Submission Draft Document	This document sets out the County and Borough Councils vision, objectives and strategic spatial approach for managing waste development over the period 2006 - 2026.

A final period of public consultation from Monday 31 March to Wednesday 14 May 2008 will now follow to allow all those with an interest to make formal representations.
