

## **South Wiltshire Core Strategy Examination**

As you know consultations have recently been carried out as to the implications that the decision to abolish RSSs will have on the South Wiltshire Core Strategy. The Inspector has been considering the various responses received including the Council's response as set out your letter of 21 June 2010. As this letter points out there is as yet no clear guidance as to what the transition arrangements will be for plans, such as the South Wiltshire Core Strategy, which are in the course of preparation. This makes it difficult for the Council and others to be clear as to the full implications that the abolition of the RSSs will have.

However, your letter of the 21 June 2010 leaves the Inspector unclear as to whether the Council wants him to complete and conclude his report on the basis of the housing and employment figures contained in the Submitted Core Strategy or whether it is saying that it cannot answer this question until an announcement is made as to what the interim arrangements will be? The Inspector will delay the completion of his report awaiting clarification on this point.
