Re: Your letter of the 7th June 2010 addressed to the Clerk to Teffont Parish Council

.My Council believes that the proposed abolition of the Regional Spatial Strategy with its housing proposals that are effectively dependant on job creation that, given the current economic situation, is far-fetched to say the least, provides a perfect opportunity for these proposals in the Core Strategy to be totally rethought. This is particularly true of the current proposals for the different sized villages which should be deleted in favour of the present system where each application for Planning Permission is looked at on its own merits and is not measured against parameters that were not particularly valid when they were first proposed a year or so ago and, both because of the credit crunch and the different attitude of the new government, are no longer of any value at all.

We believe that all this makes this part of the Core Strategy totally unsound.

I trust that you will make the Inspector aware of our views.
