NOTICE OF ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE HEARING SESSIONS

Wiltshire County Council and Swindon Borough Council (“the Councils”) have submitted their Waste Core Strategy Development Plan Document to the Secretary of State for independent Examination.

The Wiltshire and Swindon Waste Core Strategy sets out the Councils’ policy framework for guiding waste management development over the period up to 2026. The document sets out the strategic principles and policies that will shape where new waste management facilities will be developed over the life of the Plan. When adopted, the Waste Core Strategy will form part of Wiltshire and Swindon Minerals and Waste Development Framework.

The Waste Core Strategy is being independently scrutinised by Susan Holland MA DipTP MRTPI of the Planning Inspectorate who has been appointed by the Secretary of State to conduct the Examination.

The purpose of the Examination and the Hearing Sessions is to hear representations relating to the overall soundness of the Wiltshire and Swindon Waste Core Strategy Development Plan Document.
