ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE PARISHES OF
BRIXTON DEVERILL, HORNINGSHAM, KILMINGTON, KINGSTON DEVERILL,
LONGBRIDGE DEVERILL, MAIDEN BRADLEY WITH YARNFIELD, MERE AND
STOURTON WITH GASPER) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2009**

The Council of the County of Wiltshire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The County of Wilts (Maiden Bradley to Ansty Road C.25) (Weight Restriction) Order 1972 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 1972") shall be amended by the deletion from the Schedule to the Order of 1972 of the following lengths of road: -
 - "1. That length of Class III Road C.25 from its junction with B.3092 at Maiden Bradley in a general south easterly direction to its junction with B.3095 at Kingston Deverill"
 - and
 - "2. That length of Class III Road C.25 from its junction with B.3095 at Monkton Deverill in a general south easterly direction to its junction with Road A.350 at Pertwood"
2. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall, other than with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, use, or cause or permit to be used, any heavy commercial goods vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight in such a way that it proceeds in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. The Council of the County of Wiltshire is satisfied that: -
 - (a) for preventing damage to the road or buildings on or near it; and
 - (b) for preserving or improving the amenities of an area by prohibiting or restricting the use on a road or roads in that area of heavy commercial vehicles.

it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply to this Order.

4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for any heavy commercial goods vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads specified in the schedule or a road solely accessible from those roads;

- (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) in the service of the Local Authority in pursuance of statutory powers; or
 - (d) In the service of the Police Authority, Fire & Rescue Service or Ambulance Service in a case of emergency.
5. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for any heavy commercial goods vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order if the vehicle displays on its windscreen a valid Permit issued by Wiltshire County Council.
6. A Permit issued under Article 5 of this Order shall take the following form:
- (a) be circular in shape and yellow in colour;
 - (b) indicate the exemption provided by the permit;
 - (c) show the vehicle registration number;
 - (d) show the business name of the company to which the vehicle belongs or the name of the owner of the vehicle;
 - (e) show the serial number of the Permit and the date of issue and expiry of the permit; and
 - (f) be signed by an Authorised Officer of Wiltshire County Council.
7. This Order shall come into operation on xxxxxxxxxx 2009 and may be cited as The County of Wiltshire (Various Roads in the Parishes of Brixton Deverill, Horningsham, Kilmington, Kingston Deverill, Longbridge Deverill, Maiden Bradley with Yarnfield, Mere and Stourton with Gasper) (Weight Restriction) Order 2009.
