ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, CHAPMANSLADE AND
CORSLEY) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2009**

Statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order

The village of Chapmanslade straddles the A3098 which is being used extensively by Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) travelling between Somerset and Wiltshire. This road is not designated as an HGV route by Wiltshire or Somerset County Councils.

This Order will revoke the existing 17 tonne weight restriction on the A3098 in the Parish of Chapmanslade in Wiltshire and introduce a 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight restriction on the A3098 through Chapmanslade and the adjoining roads in the Parishes of Chapmanslade and Corsley using the County Council's powers under Sections 1 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, namely:

- (d) for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property;
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
