3. THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE PARISHES OF BRIXTON DEVERILL, HORNINGSHAM, KILMINGTON, KINGSTON DEVERILL, LONGBRIDGE DEVERILL, MAIDEN BRADLEY WITH YARNFIELD, MERE AND STOURTON WITH GASPER) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2009

4. THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (B3089, EAST KNOYLE) (ONE-WAY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2009

5. THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (A350, FURZE HEDGE, CHICKLADE AND EAST KNOYLE) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURN) ORDER 2009

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Wiltshire County Council proposes to make the above Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be: -

Order 1 (Ref: KAD/TRO/CHAP)

To remove the existing 17 tonne weight restriction which falls within the Wiltshire boundary on the A3098 in the Parish of Chapmanslade by amending The County of Wiltshire (A3098 in the Parish of Chapmanslade in Wiltshire and the Parish of Selwood in Somerset) (Weight Restriction) Order 1994 and to introduce a 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight restriction on the following lengths of road: -

In Parish of Chapmanslade: -

A3098 from the Wiltshire County Boundary to its junction with the A36 slip-road at Dead Maids Crossroads, C274 from its junction with the A3098 to the Corsley parish boundary, UC 824701 Mill Lane, UC 824702 Brimhill Rise, UC 824703 Wood Lane, UC 824704 (Part) Southcroft, UC 824704 (Part) Locally known as Dye House Farm Lane and UC 824705 Cleyhill Gardens and;

In the Parish of Corsley: -

C274 from the Chapmanslade parish boundary to its junction with the C275 at St Margaret's Church

The existing 17 tonne weight restriction in Selwood, Somerset will remain in place.

Order 2 (Ref: KAD/TRO/CORY)

To remove the existing one way 18 tonne weight restriction on the A362 through Corsley by revoking The County of Wiltshire (A362 Corsley) (One-Way Weight Restriction) Order 1999 and to introduce a two way 18 tonne maximum gross weight restriction on the following lengths of road: -

In the Parish of Corsley: -

A362 from the Wiltshire County Boundary to its junction with the C270 at the Picket Post Roundabout, C275 from its junction with the C274 at St Margaret's Church to its junction with the A362 at Lane End, C274 from its junction with the C275 at St Margaret's Church to its junction with the A362, UC 814401 Dertford to A362, UC 814401 Dertford, UC 814501 Court Lane, UC 814502 Mill Lane, UC 814503 The Stalls and Geys Hill from Longleat Park to A362 Lane End, UC 814504 Dertford to Whitbourne Moor, UC 814505 Roddenbury View, UC 814601 The Hollow, UC 824401 Sturford Lane, UC 824402 Temple to Knapps Gate, UC 824403 Longhedge, UC 824404 The Loop Longhedge, UC 824501 Heathway, UC 824502 Birchwood Close, UC 824503 Whitbourne Moor, UC 824504 Whitbourne Moor, UC 824505 Breach Lane, UC 824506 Sydnalls Lane and UC 834501 Cley Hill Farm Lane.

Order 3 (Ref: KAD/TRO/MBRA)

(a) To amend The County of Wilts (Maiden Bradley to Ansty Road C.25) (Weight Restriction) Order 1972 by removing the 7.5 tonne weight restriction on the following lengths of road west of the A350 and re-enacting them in the new Order: -

1. That length of Class III Road C.25 – from its junction with B.3092 at Maiden Bradley in a general south easterly direction to its junction with B.3095 at Kingston Deverill
2. That length of Class III Road C.25 – from its junction with B.3095 at Monkton Deverill in a general south easterly direction to its junction with Road A.350 Pertwood.

(b) To introduce a 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight restriction on the following lengths of road: -

In the Parishes of Brixton Deverill, Horningsham, Kilmington, Kingston Deverill, Longbridge Deverill, Maiden Bradley with Yarnfield, Mere and Stourton with Gasper: -

B3092 from its junction with the C270 Forrest Road, Horningsham to its junction with the C278 High Street, Stourton, B3095 from its junction with the A350 in Longbridge Deverill to its junction with the northern A303 slip road at Mere, C41 from its junction with the C75 Trudoxhill Road to its junction with the B3092 at Maiden Bradley, C41 from its junction with the B3092 at Maiden Bradley to its junction with the C281 in Horningsham, C41 from its junction with the C54 in Horningsham to its junction with the A350 in Longbridge Deverill, C55 from its junction with the C41 at Yarnfield Gate to its junction with the B3092 in Stourton with Gasper, C270 from its junction with B3092 to its junction with the C281 in Horningsham, C279 from its junction with the C41 in Maiden Bradley to its junction with the C55 in Kilmington, C282 from its junction with the C270 in Horningsham to its junction with the C41 in Maiden Bradley, C341 from its junction with the C279 in Kilmington to its junction with the B3092 in Stourton with Gasper and the following unclassified roads: -

In the Parish of Brixton Deverill: -

UC 863801 Woodcombe Lane and UC 863802 Manor Farm Lane and;

In the Parish of Horningsham: -

UC 804101 Scotland, UC 804102 The Common, UC 814001 Pottle Street, UC 814002 The Island, UC 814101 Lodge Road, UC 814103 Chapel Street and West Common, UC 824101 White Street, UC 824102 Rowes Hill (Part), UC 824103 Church Lane, UC 824104 Rowes Hill (Part) and Newbury and UC 824105 Gentle Street (Part) & UC 824106 Gentle Street (Part) and;

In the Parish of Kilmington: -

UC 743501 Tower Road, UC 773501 Cote Lane (Part) & UC 773502 Cote Lane (Part), UC 773601 Church Road, UC 773602 Harepit Lane, UC 773701 Cokers Lane, UC 783501 White Sheet Lane, UC 783601 Coombe Barn Lane, Norton Ferris and UC 783602 Lane west of B3092, Norton Ferris and;

In the Parish of Kingston Deverill: -

UC 843701, UC 843702, UC 843703 & UC 853702 Unnamed roads, and UC 853701 Whitepits, UC 853703 Keysley Farm Lane Monkton Deverill and;

In the Parish of Longbridge Deverill: -

UC 864001 Homefields and UC 864002 Manor Lane Hill Deverill and;

In the Parish of Maiden Bradley: -

UC 773802 Grange Farm Lane, UC 794001 Mill Pond Lane, UC 803801 Rodmead Farm Lane and UC 803802 Back Lane and;

In the Parish of Stourton with Gasper: -

UC 773503 Long Lane.

This Order will exempt specific vehicles issued with permits so that they can travel from Yarnfield Gate to the B3092 south of the restriction and vice versa.

Order 4 (Ref: KAD/TRO/EKNO)

To remove the existing 7.5 tonne weight restriction on the B3089 between the A303 and the A350 by revoking The County of Wiltshire (B3089, East Knoyle) (Weight Restriction) Order 1984 and to introduce a one way 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight restriction to prohibit east bound heavy commercial goods vehicles on the following length of road:-

B3089 – from a point 175 metres east of its junction with the A303 at Willoughby Hedge to a point 135 metres west of its junction with the A350.

Order 5 (Ref: KAD/TRO/CHIC)

To introduce a Prohibition of right hand turn for heavy commercial goods vehicles in excess of 7.5 tonne maximum gross weight from the A350 (Warminster to Shaftesbury Road) at Furze Hedge onto the A303 (Amesbury to Mere Road westbound) at Furze Hedge.
