4. Purpose of processing

The Fleet Compliance Team will process your personal information for the following purposes:

- maintaining our own accounts and records
- administering the assessment and collection of taxes and other revenue including benefits and grants
- licensing and regulatory activities
- local fraud initiatives
- crime prevention and prosecution offenders including the use of CCTV
- corporate administration and all activities we are required to carry out as a data controller and public authority
- the provision of all commercial services including the administration and enforcement of parking regulations and restrictions
- data matching under local and national fraud initiatives
- carrying out consultation

5. Legal basis for processing

Our processing shall be lawful because <u>at least one</u> of the following will apply:

- (a) the data subject has given consent to the Council for processing of their personal data for one or more specific purposes;
- (b) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Council is subject;

(c) processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Council;

If your special category data is processed, in addition to one of the above, processing will be necessary because at least one of the following shall also apply:

- (a) the data subject has given explicit consent to the processing of those personal data for one or more specified purposes,
- (b) for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims or whenever courts are acting in their judicial capacity;
- (c) processing is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest

6. Recipients or categories of recipients
