4. Freight Update Wiltshire

B4069 Draycot Cerne to Lyneham

The roadworks on the A350 have now been completed so the temporary weight restriction that was in place on the B4069 for the duration of the works is no longer in operation. Further monitoring of HGVs on the route will be undertaken later in the year.

A361 – Seend to Littleton Fork

Further monitoring will be undertaken, hopefully before the summer holidays, to assess the impact of the HGV signage that was erected last summer.

Wynsome Street, Trowbridge

Atkins has now completed their Technical Note on the findings of the freight study. It concludes that Wynsome Street is an appropriate route for freight in comparison to the A361 through Trowbridge and the use and function of the route should not be changed. However, as Wynsome Street is not strictly part of the PRN, any incorrect directional signs that have been identified will be replaced with white backed signs once the existing signs are due for renewal.

Freight Assessment and Priority Mechanism (FAPM)

Wiltshire Council are proposing a change to the FAPM process to ensure that all routes that are assessed reflect the top freight priorities of each Community Area in Wiltshire. A report outlining the changes is due to be considered by the Cabinet Member for Highways and Transport shortly.

5. Freight Update Swindon

6. SEP/Local Transport Body

Following updates at previous meetings, **RM** provided a brief summary on the devolution of major transport scheme funding, firstly through Local Transport Bodies (including the Swindon and Wiltshire Local Transport Body) and now through the Swindon and Wiltshire Local Enterprise Partnership Board (as set out in the Swindon and Wiltshire Strategic Economic Plan). RM then outlined three Wiltshire Council schemes which had recently been progressed through the SWLTB:

- A350 Chippenham Bypass Improvement Bumpers Farm
- A429 Malmesbury (Dyson) Improvements
- A350 Yarnbrook/West Ashton Relief Road

PM highlighted Swindon schemes focussed on Eastern Villages development and also upgrades at M4 J15 and M4 J16.
