

New Roads and Street Works Act 1991

Section 58 Notice of Substantial Road Works

Three months' notice is hereby given that Wiltshire Council intends to carry out substantial road works.

The streets in which these works will take place are: Beanacre Road, Western Way, Shurnhold, Challeymead, Semington Roundabout in Melksham.

The work is expected to affect the entire carriageway of;

- Beanacre Road, Melksham; from its junction with Western Way for approximately 430 meters in a northerly direction.
- Western Way, Melksham; from its junction with Semington Roundabout, to its junction with A350 Western Way Roundabout.
- Shurnhold, Melksham; From its junction with A350 Western Way Roundabout, to its junction with Roundpond.
- Challeymead, Melksham; from its junction with A350 Western Way roundabout for approximately 150 meters in a westerly direction.
- Semington Roundabout, Melksham; from its junction with Western Way for a distance of approximately 35 meters in an easterly direction.
- As per below drawing.

Work is expected to commence on 4th February 2019 and the restriction will come into force on the 29th November 2019.

The works notified will include the following: Improvements to existing roundabout. Work will include installation of a new traffic signal junction, adjustments to the roundabouts and approaches, new surfacing, lining and signing improvements.

Subject to the exemptions in the Acts and Regulations under it, no road or street works may be executed for a period of five years from completion of the works described in Paragraph 4 without the consent of the said highway authority, which is not to be unreasonably withheld.
