

Flood Investigation Report

Site: Court lane Corsley

1. Details of the Flood Event

Reason for investigation:

Parish complaint that run off from field via track enters Court lane Corsley and floods properties and blocks gullies at bottom of hill.

Location:

Court Lane Corsley

Identified source(s):

Run off from field onto Court Lane via small track. Brings water and silt onto highway.

Cause/pathway:

Run off water from field adjacent Court Lane.

Extent of flooding:

The flooding mainly confined to the highway at bottom of hill and run off via private driveways into properties in Court Lane.

History of flooding:

Several flooding events over 20yrs. Known problem area. Site has been attended on a number of occasions with gully tanker.

Correspondence on parish file and updating parish by phone and email. Met community co-ordinator and Highway Area Engineer to action way forward. Arranged to meet farmer,(Done) but slow response. Highways Act notice to be issued.

Wrote to landowner on 09/07/15 and 31st July 2015 requesting works done asap. Notice to follow. Contacted land owners agent on 04/09/15 to chase up landowner prior to notice being issued.
