- 4. Data Protection Act 1998. In order to improve our services to you, we may share the information supplied by you in this form with other parts of the Council. We will not disclose your details to anyone outside the Council, except in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
- 5. **Safety Glass.** This is required within certain locations of building. The Wessex Group has produced guidance on where impact resistant glazing is needed contact any of our offices for a copy.
