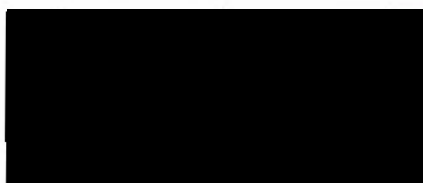
**Wiltshire Council (Traffic Management) Permit Scheme Order 2020**

Wiltshire Council ("the Permit Authority") acting as the local highway authority approves the permit scheme referred to as the Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme and in exercise of its powers conferred by Sections 33A (2) and Part 3 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and all other enabling powers and after consultation makes the following order;

1. This order comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 and maybe cited as the "Traffic Management (Wiltshire Council) Permit Scheme Order 2020".
2. In this order, the preamble and schedule 1 hereto;  
"specified streets" means the definition given by regulation 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007.  
The "**Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Works**" or "**Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme**" or "**WCPS**" means the permit scheme set out in schedule 1 to this order.
3. The Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme complies with the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Scheme Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and with all other applicable primary and secondary related legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes and does not exceed those powers under such legislation.
4. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, shall apply to the specified streets within the Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme.
5. Transitional arrangements for when the Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme comes into force are set out within the Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme.
6. The Wiltshire Council Permit Scheme comes into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020.
