Para badminton

Dan is from Chippenham and is a member of the GB Para badminton Performance Squad. In 2019 he won a silver medal in the Men's Singles SL3 category at the World Championships and then went on to win Tokyo Paralympics test event. He is ranked Number 1 in Europe and Number 2 in the World.

**Jessica Daykin**  
Gymnastics

Jessica is from Little Pannell near Devizes and is a member of the British Gymnastics Senior squad. At the 2019 British Championships Jessica won a silver medal on the Beam.



**Stephanie Millward MBE**  
Para swimming

Box swimmer Stephanie is a member of British Swimming's Podium Potential Performance squad. At the 2019 World Championships she won two gold medals as part of the victorious teams in the 34pt 4x100m Freestyle Relay and 34pt 4x100m Medley Relay – the latter in a stunning world record. She will be aiming to qualify for the Tokyo Paralympics this summer where she hopes to add to the total ten Paralympic medals she already possesses.



**Amelia Bissett**  
Tennis

Devizes tennis player Amelia is a member of the Great Britain Under 16/Under 18 squad. In 2019 she won eight ITF Under 18 doubles titles and played at Junior Wimbledon. She is currently ranked UK Under 16 Number 2.



**Tom Gale**  
Athletics

High jumper Tom is from Trowbridge and is a member of the British Athletics World Class Performance Program. In 2019 he won gold at the Under 23 European Championships and a bronze at the British Championships. In February this year he jumped the Tokyo Olympics qualifying height of two meters and thirty-three centimetres. He then followed this up by becoming British Indoor Champion two weeks ago.



**Emily Rowlands**  
Hockey

Hockey player Emily is from Box and is a member of the Hampstead and Westminster team that play in the Investec Women's Hockey Premier Division as well as being part of the Welsh National Team.



**Lauren Booth**  
Para cycling

Chippenham's Lauren won an unprecedented six gold medals on the track and the road at the INAS Global Games in Australia last year. She will be seeking to retain her world titles later this year.



**Fenella Langridge**  
Triathlon

Fenella is from Shrewton near Salisbury and is a long distance triathlete who burst onto the world stage in 2019 by winning the Ironman 70.3 in Barcelona and followed this by winning a silver medal at the Ironman 70.3 European championships.



**Sarah Wilson**  
Modern pentathlon

Trowbridge's Sarah is a member of the British Modern Pentathlon's Development squad. At the 2019 Under 19 World Championships she won a silver in the Mixed Relay and a bronze in the Team event. Sarah is ranked World Under 19 Number 1 for the Mixed Relay.



**Hannah Brown**  
Sprint canoe

Melksham canoeist Hannah is a member for British Canoeing's Women K4 squad who are aiming to secure Tokyo qualification later this spring and then hopes to compete at the Olympics in the summer.



**Lucy-Jane Matthews**  
Athletics

Salisbury's Lucy-Jane was selected for the 2019 Under 20 European Athletics Championships aged just 16 years old. Competing against women four years older than her, she won a bronze medal in the 100 metres hurdles. She is the new British Under 18 record holder and is ranked UK Under 20 Number 1 and Under 18 Number 1 in Europe.
